Noting that human rights and humanism should be above all the other considerations, I deem it proper for the authorities of Nagorno-Karabakh and Azerbaijan Republic to display mutual tolerance and take necessary measures for returning the corpses of the Armenian and Azerbaijanis.

I call on the Human Rights Defender of Nagorno-Karabakh Republic Yuri Hayrapetyan to ask the authorities of Nagorno-Karabakh Republic to return the corpses of Azerbaijanis Mubariz Ibragimov and Farid Akhmedov.

At the same time, I call on Elmira Suleymanova, the Human Rights Defender of Azerbaijan Republic, to show humanity and demand from the authorized bodies to allow the international experts to examine the circumstances of the capture and the death of the Armenian citizen. I also call upon for taking measures in order to return Manvel Saribekyan's corpse to the Republic of Armenia.
