RoA Government Staff Delays Solution of the Issue Connected with Free Movement of Children with Disabilities

As of today, police officers fine parents of children with disabilities for parking the car in an inappropriate place. Few months ago Ombudsman Karen Andreasyan made a statement on this issue and taking into account the urgency of the matter proposed to the RA Prime Minister to make amendments to the relevant points of the Government decision, as well as to provide appropriate privileges to parents or guardians of children with a status of "a disabled child".

Approving the Ombudsman's proposal the Prime Minister gave an assignment to make appropriate amendments in the Decision. In conformity with the assignment the RA Ministry of Transport and Communications prepared a project of making amendments to the RA Government decision within short periods. According to the project the privileges stipulated for people with disabilities of the first and second groups will also concern parents or guardians of children having a status of "a disabled child".

However, so far the draft decision hasn't been submitted in the agenda of the RA Government sessions due to the delays by the RA Government. As a result, as of today police officers fine parents of children with disabilities for parking the car in an inappropriate place.

Ombudsman supposes that the RA Government staff will take into consideration the urgency of the issue and will include this proposal in the RA Government sessions agenda as soon as possible, and the Government will approve the project thus solving disabled children's problem of free and easy movement.
