

Ombudsman and Tufenkian Charitable Foundation addressed RA Prime Minister to support state sponsored asylum

“Tufenkian” Charitable Foundation with support of the RA Human Rights Defender has addressed a letter to the RA Prime-Minister Tigran Sargsyan with request to provide state care and support to the victims of domestic violence for having state sponsored asylum, taking into account the fact that domestic violence is very actual in our society and joint approach and efforts will be necessary to overcome the issue.

Since 1999 “Tufenkian” Charitable Foundation has implemented and financed a number of various social projects aimed at solution of issues such as vulnerable families, women rights defense, gender issues, environmental and other social problems of great importance.

Since 2010 the “Women’s Support Centre” project of “Tufenkian” Charitable Foundation has been functioning which deals with the issues of women subjected to violence. Within the framework of the project beneficiaries are provided with juridical, psychological support, consultation and social services. Adjunct to the project there is also an asylum which is envisaged for urgent cases of domestic violence, when the life of the beneficiary and his/her children is under danger and there is a problem of secret asylum provision.
