

The criminal case instituted against Marina Poghosyan is quashed

In the criminal case instituted against Marina Poghosyan, a human rights defender, no elements of fraud have been detected: the case is quashed.

Marina Poghosyan, Head of the “Veles” Law firm, informed that groundless criminal proceedings were instituted against her. In her letter addressed to the Ombudsman Poghosyan particularly complained regarding the recent criminal case instituted against her.

Based on the complaint, the Ombudsman sent written requests to the Office of the Prosecutor General, as well as the investigative Committee.

Today the Ombudsman was informed by the Investigative Committee that the preliminary investigation confirmed the absence of fraud in the actions of Marina Poghosyan. As a result of it, the case was dismissed.

Today the Deputy Ombudsman informed Poghosyan regarding the dismissal of the case.
