On the tragic terrorist event in Nice

Tirana, 15 July 2016

On behalf of the Association of Mediterranean Ombudsmen (AOM), the President of AOM and Albanian People's Advocate Mr. Igli Totozani expresses profound grief for the victims of the latest tragic terrorist events that were perpetrated in Nice.

Mr. Totozani denounces vigorously the recent terrorist events as outrageous act that aim at instilling fear and panic amongst the French society, one of the outstanding democratic societies of the contemporary world.

In light of the events, Mr. Totozani stated that “This is a day of woe for the French people, a day of pain and indignation for what happened – for the innocent lives cut short from an appalling terrorist act committed on an emblematic and meaningful day like the Bastille Day.”
